

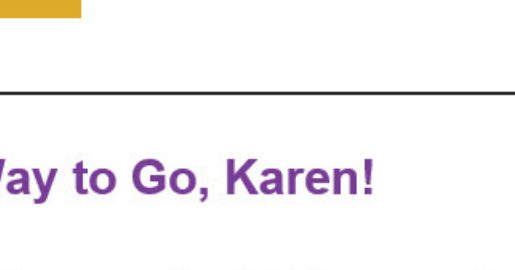

**Pantone** just unveiled their 2019 Color Palette for Commercial and Residential Interiors!

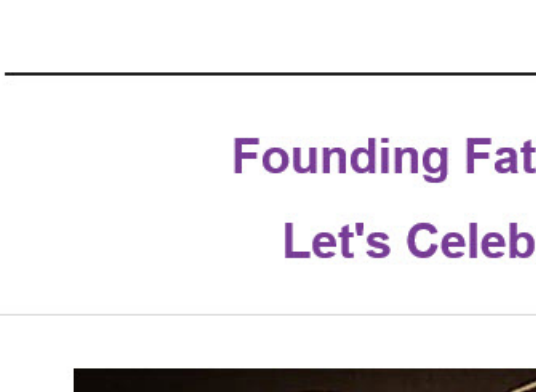

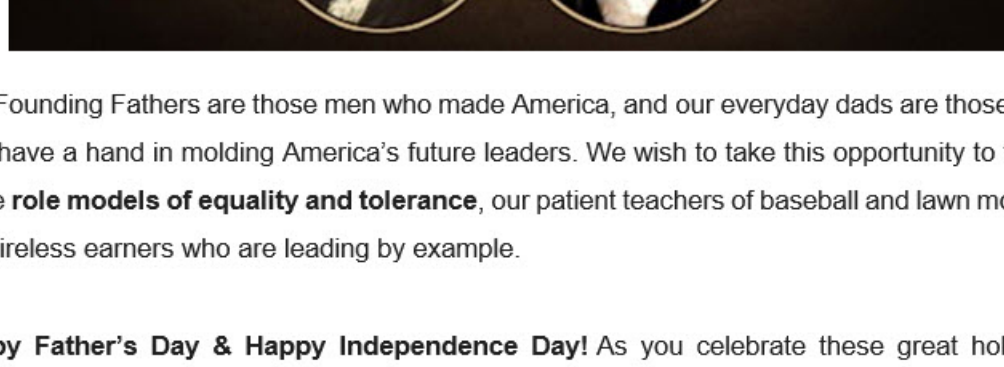
## FMP Credentials: Way to Go, Karen!

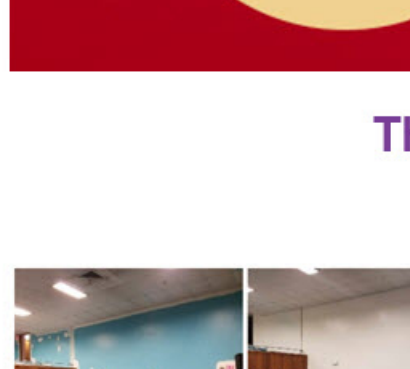

## Tips and Tricks: How to Properly Clean Your Grill

With summer here, it is time to clean and maintain your outdoor kitchen: the grill! With burgers, hot dogs and more cooking on the barbeque, we have tips to fight grease, rust, stains and more:

**#4: How to properly clean your grill**

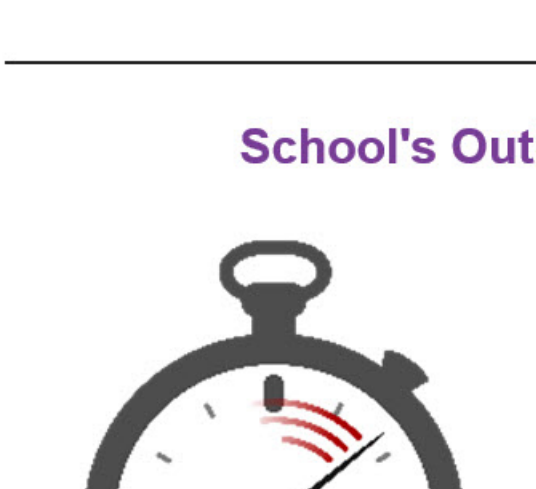
From May through the summer, the grill becomes more than important...it acts like a second kitchen. Surely, you would not wish to cook in dirty pots and pans in your kitchen, so why do people neglect to properly maintain their "outdoor kitchen?" The task may seem daunting and perhaps people believe that the extreme cooking heat will burn off all remaining residue, but a pristine barbeque looks nicer, cooks food better and lasts longer. Let's get busy protecting your investment!

- Degrease the grates:** Easy Off® Grill Cleaner can be used, and you can even power wash the grates (if you remove the propane tank!). But here are two simple tricks you can try:
  - Mix 2 cups of vinegar and 1 cup of baking soda in a garbage bag. Seal the grates in the garbage bag with a rubber band. Remove the grates and rinse them off with water.
  - Turn the grill on for a few minutes to warm it up, then shut it off and \ using a heavy-duty scrub pad (not a wire brush) remove the food bits before the grill cools off.
- Rust on the grates?** Brush your grill grates with a soft brush to remove as much rust as you can. Put your grate on your barbeque and sprinkle it generously with baking soda. Turn your barbeque on and watch the baking soda begin to bubble and remove the rust. Turn off the grill and let it cool down.
- Prevent stains:** Cover the ground with a BBQ pad that is hose-able and use cutting boards to prevent dribbles and drips from setting into wood tables. Keep wipes handy to remove splatters before they bake on to furniture and flooring surfaces.
- Invest in a good grill cover:** Protecting your grill from the elements will surely extend its life. Covers can be easily hosed off (which prevents you from having to remove bird poop and pollen from your grill!).

Be safe and enjoy the BBQ season. Get cooking!

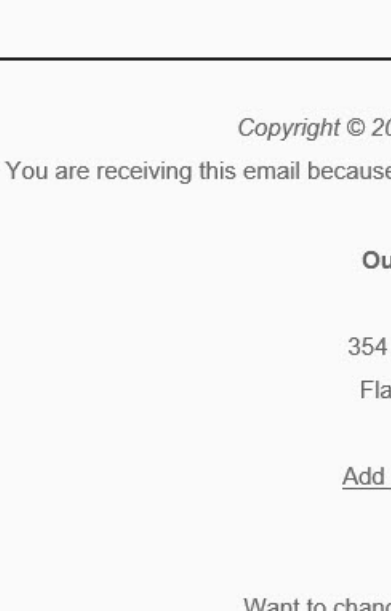
## We All Scream for Ice Cream... Part 2!
