## TEAMPAR COLLECTS THOUSANDS OF TOYS TO BENEFIT JERSEY BATTERED WOMEN'S SHELTER

Company Marks 18 Years of Charitable Giving

**FLANDERS, N.J.** – For 18 years, TeamPAR has sponsored a holiday toy drive to benefit the Jersey Battered Women's Shelter, and for 18 years, the initiative has brought immeasurable joy to the children and families served by the shelter. This year's Annual Toy Drive was a success once again, this time bringing in enough toys to fill 30 Santa-sized sacks and 10 large boxes, plus more than \$700 worth of gift cards and cash donations.

The donations are anticipated to support more than 450 children and 225 families through the shelter's holiday boutique, where mothers and grandmothers get to shop and select between three and six items for each of their children. They even get to leave the shop with gift cards and wrapping paper in hand.

According to JBWS, TeamPAR's haul included a play kitchen, two skateboards, six Razor scooters, eight bicycles and dozens of balls, dolls, toy cars and action figures. Not all donations were toys, however. In addition to the monetary contributions, at least 24 new coats and two large boxes of diapers were collected.

"I feel so blessed," says TeamPAR president Karen Rossilli-Kiefer. "For 18 consecutive years, TeamPAR's toy drive has been supported by dedicated Selfless Elves that lift up the clients of JBWS, and it is a joy to see new elves organically continue to join us. Karma counts, and together we ensure these children in need receive the spirit of the holiday season and believe a positive New Year is possible. It truly takes a village, and I am so grateful for the strong community that supports TeamPAR's efforts."

Many New Jersey-based organizations joined TeamPAR in this year's philanthropic effort, including the Turtle Back Zoo, which accepts new toys, canned goods and gently used coats in lieu of admission during the holiday season and then hands over the toys to TeamPAR for its JBWS holiday initiative.
